

- Independence in writing
- Use of correct punctuation e.g. capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, question marks, exclamation marks.
- Reading sentences back to themselves and others.
- Editing own writing
- Adding detail to their writing through use of :
 - Adjectives -description
 - Verbs –action
 - Alliteration –same sound
 - Conjunctions –joining ideas
 - Suffix- word added at the end of a root word to write in past tense. Eg: walk- walked.
 - Past-tense
 - Prefix –word added in front of a root word to change meaning e.g. rewrite
 - Different forms of narrative –poster, letter, fact file, character description & thought bubbles.
 - <u>Reading-</u> comprehension, ask questions, make comparisons, give their opinions on a text.

How you can support at home

Spellings

-at the moment we are mainly focusing on common exception words (tricky words) and using our phonics to spell other words.

Reading - please read with your child as often as you can.

Writing - write sentences containing the correct punctuation.

Counting- practise counting backwards and forwards in 1s,2s, 5s and 10s. Practical maths tasks.

Talking - After reading with your child, please talk to them to help them develop a varied vocabulary. Talk to them about events that are happening in the world etc.

Independence - to help children to be able to think and solve problems, please encourage them to think and do things for themselves at home. Teach your child to tie their shoelaces.

Phonics

- ▶ The PSC will be taking place week of 10th June.
- It is important your children are in every day.
- The children have been doing practise PSC's throughout the year with Miss Miller so this will be no different for them.
- Children understand the difference between an alien word and a real word.
